It is the purpose-driven brainchild of a group of High Five youth volunteers from Central Singapore Community Development Council aimed at nurturing the Arts in youths, reaching out to the public and raising awareness on the High Five Youth Programme and its adopted beneficiaries. The performances include rock music, hip-hop dance, mime and puppetry.
