# BIGGEST ARTS FESTIVAL



Seven top international acts and many more local ones are featured in this year's Central Singapore District Arts Festival, "Streets Come Alive", which runs until Nov 28. The annual event, first staged in 2007, is possibly the biggest held since with shows at 24 venues.

Mr Gilbert Fernandez, Central Singapore CDC's deputy general manager for community projects, added: "These international acts provide us an opportunity to bring quality non-ticketed arts programmes to our residents."

Six of the seven acts are Japanese, and include mimes, magicians and jugglers. The seventh is American Kenny Ahern, a clown who has performed at the White House.

The best known is Ojarus, a quartet who blends comedy with mime and magic. They will perform for three days, Nov 6 to Nov 8.

Their first appearance will be at Arty Party, on Nov 6 at Far East Plaza. The show which usually wraps up the festival, opens it this year with four hours of entertainment, starting at 5pm.

Appearing with Ojarus are Hyro, whose act has a little mime, acrobatics and juggling plus lots of humour, and Tikuriino, who mixes magic, mime and dance.

Shows featuring at least two of the performers — the others are magician Chiki and jugglers Pepper Zero and Miss Sullivan — will be held at five other venues under the Community Life Arts Programme (CLAP!) and 18 other places in Central Singapore District.

## OTHER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Circus workshops held daily at OnePeople.sg (381 Toa Payoh Lorong 1), from Nov 23 to Nov 26. Basic circus skills, such as plate spinning and juggling, will be taught at each two-hour session.
- Photo-taking sessions at all 24 performance venues using Lomographic cameras. Each camera produces a different photographic effect.
